

Minutes of CCA Meeting on Friday, March 21, 2008

The meeting began at 5:00 pm and was presided over by Jim Richardson. Other members present: Linda Harper, Martha Hamlin, Dan Higgins, Barbara Reisert and Jack Harrald.

- The Bylaws of the Claiborne Community Association were reviewed. Article I. Name and Purpose, Section 4 was amended to delete the word “non-political”.
- The anonymous letter written to the Claiborne Clarion was discussed and it was decided that 1) Barbara Reisert will print a response that unsigned letters will not be accepted and 2) some of the issues in the letter (e.g. the misconception that the committee try to tear down the church) will be addressed by Kirke Harper at the public meeting on March 29, 2008.
- The yard sale is slated for April 19, 2008. Linda Harper will advertise it in the Star Democrat as well as in flyers left at the Post Office. Members of the community who need help in getting items to the site will be helped by Jim Richardson and others. Donations to the CCA will be encouraged. Kathy Jo has agreed to let us use her lot.
- Neavitt Post Office received its approval... hooray!
- Committee agreed that it would be wise to add some long-time residents to the CCA roster. Bill Sewell and Ted Jones were suggested as possibilities.
- Community Dinner and Meeting: Kirke will create the agenda. The committee suggested that a group of three people be chosen to be church trustees. We will need to elect a nominating committee of three people to come up with a slate of officers for the July meeting.
