

Public Hearing scheduled about Claiborne Road Resurfacing

A Bill was introduced by the County Council on July 10 to authorize improvements to Claiborne Road. For anyone wanting to attend, a public hearing is scheduled on Tuesday, August 14, 2018 at 6:30 pm in the Bradley Meeting Room, South Wing, Talbot County Courthouse, 11 North Washington Street, Easton, MD 21601. The Bill, if enacted, will authorize improvements to Claiborne Road as a capital project. The proposed improvement will mill two inches of tar and chip and resurface the road with tar and chip as well as drainage improvements to improve traffic safety. The Bill will authorize up to \$50,000 for the project. If approved and signed, the improvements could begin within 60 days upon approval.
