Brick Walk

Talbot Council-Grant Proposal

Jack Herrald made grant proposal presentation to Talbot Council. Had to reinforce the point that the grant is for protecting the Village, not just restoring the jetty. Council voted to approve. Jack feels the county staff is interested and cooperative. If we get the grant, will then need a partnership agreement.

Hi-Fi/Microphone

Received as a gift to the hall but no stands. Stands are \$45 each – Kirke will see what he can figure out.
